Langmiel Estate in the town of Tanunda is situated in the heart of the Barossa Valley, South Australia. The Barossa Valley begins some 50 km East of Adelaide and stretches for 40km to Tanunda, which is set in the rolling valleys of the Adelaide Hills.

The Barossa Valley is well known all over the World especially for its quality wines; and this area produces over half the countries wine. The Barossa is also steeped in history. Quaint villages with tree-lined streets and historic stone cottages seem to be everywhere and with a growing population and a need for new housing subdivisions, StreetPrint takes a pride in becoming part of this popular destination, providing the community with a decorative paving finish that replicates the traditional look of European bricks.

This project was 680m² in total and used the popular, Diagonal Herringbone pattern, which was used in conjunction with a Stacked Brick Border to create the required finish. The main section of the Texturing was completed in a Terracotta colour and complimented by a Slate coloured border.

The printing was achieved using an infrared heater, which softens the asphalt to allow compaction of a template into the surface thus creating the brick impression. This was then coated with the StreetBond coating system, with the desired colour combination, creating what will be a lasting impression in the beautiful Barossa Valley.
