Leichhardt Terrace footpath is the first footpath application of **StreetPrint** in Alice Springs and The Northern Territory.

Commissioned by the Alice Springs Town Council the 1000m<sup>2</sup> project was conducted over a 5 day period.

An Infrared Asphalt Heater was used to reheat the existing asphalt which had been laid 2 weeks prior to the **StreetPrint** application. This reheat method allows the client to use preferred asphalt suppliers and contractors without disrupting them or the **StreetPrint** crew during construction.

The entire work site including planter surrounds and grates are bordered with a Stacked Brick pattern in the StreetBond Brick Colourant.

The main footpath area is in an Offset Brick Pattern with all driveway entrances in Diagonal Herringbone finished in the StreetBond Terracotta Colourant.

In conjunction with this the splitter islands were printed in Offset Brick and coated in Terracotta to complete the Streetscape project.

An interesting note to this project was the speed of completion with a small crew. It was conducted in very hot weather which aided the printing speed and coating cure time enabling the **StreetPrint** to be completed at an optimal speed.
