Mt. Lofty House Grand Mercure in Craffers SA is a high profile historic home built between 1852 and 1858. **StreetPrint** was applied to the front entrance in the shape of a horse shoe and at the back entrance a rectangle shape. All areas were bordered by established gardens and the biggest challenge was the confined working space.

StreetPrint was tendered and priced as a presentation for the South Australian marketplace. The attraction for **StreetPrint** was the continuous flexible surface and ability to provide a decorative finish desired by the client to compliment the surrounding trees and vegetation without maintenance issues.

Day One: Work commenced in association with Ace Asphalts who layed the asphalt in the **StreetPrint** areas and surrounding car parks. The imprinting took place behind the paving crew while the asphalt retained heat. Finishing touches to the printing were applied using a Streethater and hand tools.

Day Two: Two coats of Slate **StreetBond** SP50 were applied to the entire printed area including borders using the Rapid Sprayer, brooming and on the final coat back rolling. The borders were coated with Brick SP50 using brooms only and the project completed with a clear sealer .

As a result of careful layout and preperation the success of the project was evidenced by the attached glowing reference received from the manager of the **Grand Mercure Hotel**.
