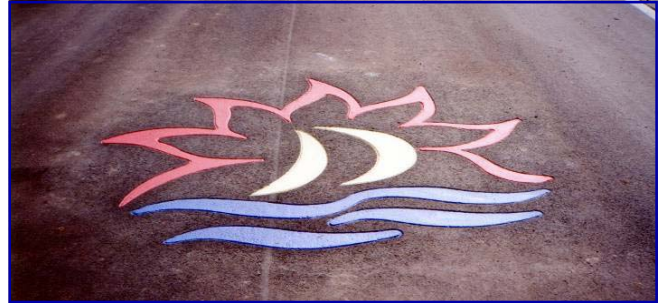




## Point Cook Flower Jamieson Way, Point Cook Peet & Co Developments

Point Cook Garden Estate Melbourne began 3 years ago with Stage 1 featuring 500m<sup>2</sup> of **StreetPrint**. Since that time 12 Stages have been completed.

At the beginning the developer Peet & Co and Engineer Fisher Stewart were approached to consider the Point Cook Estate motif to be featured at the four entrances to the estate and adjacent to the sales office and display homes.

The idea was accepted and within a short period the template was designed and built.

A two man crew printed the 3m x 2m template at four separate locations using an infrared (reheat) machine combined with a plate compactor to imprint the custom template.

Three custom colours were manufactured after consultation with the client. All four of the sites were completed in 8 hours.

12 months later the clients' new design engineer decided the colours were no longer appropriate and requested a change utilizing our standard colour range. These colours remain to this day.

Each flower was completed at a cost of \$950.00 each with the client purchasing the template to be used on future projects. The template is retained by the authorised applicator on their behalf.

A very visual welcome to the estate was created and the client was very satisfied.
